14/58	VILLAGE HALL HIRE CHARGES
	At the last meeting, Council adopted a finance report from the Clerk, which amongst other things, highlighted the costs of operating the village hall. Council need to consider the charges for room hire at the hall. Various proposals were made but nothing could be agreed.

Resolved	that the Clerk will liaise with the residents concerned and the NELC tree officer with a view to trying to agree a course of action agreeable to all parties.
