Humberside Police provided a report detailing 74 crimes in the Freshney Ward. Of these 14 offences had been reported in Great Coates being 8 theft from motor vehicle, 3 interference with motor vehicle, 2 burglaries and 1 attempted burglary. One male had been arrested for some of the offences and extensive patrols have been conducted throughout the village.

Cllr C. Procter confirmed that NELC were no longer in discussions with developers of Grimsby West. He updated councillors on plans to resurface the A180 and had pressed Cabinet in respect of the Woad Lane pavements.
